August 3rd to August 5th

What to Expect when you get on the bus:

Day 1:

We will be making several stops to pick-up campers along the way but will be heading straight to Boston. You may be the first on the bus or the sixth, either way when you board the bus there will be a short introduction to campers who have already arrived. During the initial tour we will store your gear in one of the bunks and then hit the road. As it will be early in the morning when we leave, we often play a movie while everyone wakes up. As we travel we will play some games and begin getting to know each other. On the way to camp we will divide our group into “work crews”. (Don’t be scared, it shouldn’t cause any blisters) but as we are a team everyone will need to pitch in - I am sure it will be fun. Each crew will have a chance to help cook, clean, and refuel the bus. During our first day in Boston we will visit the Boston Aquarium, Quincy Market and the Freedom Trail. When we are ready we will travel to our campsite at Salisbury Beach State Reservation. Depending on weather some things to do at camp may include swimming, playing ball, cooking S’mores on the campfire, playing cards or listening to a story.

Day 2:

We will start the day with a great camp breakfast and enjoying the campground before heading back to Boston. In Boston we will visit the Museum of Science and Omni Theater before going to Fenway Park to watch the Red Sox take on the Cleveland Indians at 7:10 pm. After the game we will return to Salisbury Beach State Reservation.

Day 3:

Today we will enjoy some well earned relaxation time at camp and at Salisbury Beach before heading home in the afternoon.
